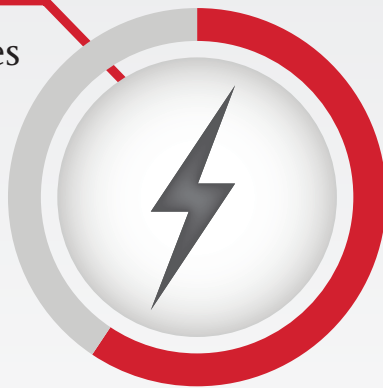

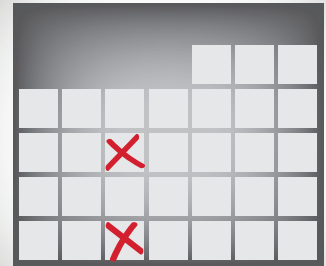
How to Take *Charge* of Your Batteries

The average cost of a new battery will run you between \$2,000 to \$6,000. *Protect your investment.* In order to prolong the life of your batteries, we have a few tips for maintenance.

Charge batteries fully for about 6-8 hours with a 2 hour cool down period.



Incorporate *bi-monthly water checks and equalizing charges* into your battery maintenance schedule.



Wait until the battery is at least *80% discharged* before charging.



After charging, *check battery water levels.* If a battery does need water, fill it to just above the grid plate.
